


SCHEMATIC

FILTER



1. Chloride filter

- First, it removes large dust particles in the air.
- Please take it apart and clean it periodically.
- It can be washed with water.

2. Pre-filter

- Removes fine dust.
- It can collect about 90% of grade 3.0~10nm dust.
- It cannot be washed with water.

3. HEPA filter


- Removes ultra-fine dust.
- H13 grade, 0.3nm dust can be collected up to 99.97%.
- It cannot be washed with water.



PRODUCT PART NAME



CONTROL PANEL NAME


WAS 2200 CONTROL PANEL NAME



- 1. Filter check lamp: Lights up when the air flow of the filter is not smooth.
- Power lamp
 - : It is possible to check whether power is applied.(Lights up when power is applied)
- 3. Circuit Breaker(Reset) When overcurrent (over 10A) flows, the power is cut off. After resolving the cause, press the button to operate normally.
- 4. Air volume regulator
 - : The fan can be turned on and off, and the air volume can be continuously adjusted to suit the location. (H: High, L:Low)
- 5. Pressure sensor
 - : It is a passage that detects the pressure difference between inside and outside.



WAS 3400 CONTROL PANEL NAME



- 1. Differential pressure gauge: By checking the pressure, you can check when to replace the filter. When the scale is 0.15kPa or more, replace the filter.
- 2. Filter check lamp: Lights up when the air flow of the filter is not smooth.
- 3. Power lamp
 - : It is possible to check whether power is applied.(Lights up when power is applied)
- 4. Circuit Breaker(Reset): When overcurrent (over 10A) flows, the power is cut off. After resolving the cause, press the button to operate normally.
- 5. Air volume regulator
 - : The fan can be turned on and off, and the air volume can be continuously adjusted to suit the location. (H: High, L:Low)
- 6. Pressure sensor

THINGS TO CHECK BEFORE REPORTING A MALFUNCTION

SYMPTOM	CAUSE	SOLUTION
Can't drive at all.	Is the power plug unplugged?	Be sure to plug it into an outlet.
	Is the power lamp not lit?	Electricity is not being supplied through the outlet. Please check the power supply.
	Is the circuit breaker tripped?	An overcurrent has flowed and has been shut off. After resolv¬ing the cause, click the Reset button.
Low air volume and low noise.	Are there any obstructions blocking the air flow?	Remove obstacles to facilitate airflow.
	Is the filter dusty or dead?	Please clean and replace the filter.
Dust flows out of the outlet.	Are the filters installed in the opposite direction?	Check the direction on the side of the pre- filter and HEPA filter and install it correctly.
	Is the filter damaged?	Please replace the filter.
The filter check lamp lights up.	Is about 80% of the filter area not stuck?	Please clean and replace the filter



FILTER REPLACEMENT METHOD

WAS 2200 / WAS 3400 MODEL






2. Pull the filter case and remove it.



3. Loosen the filter case fixing screw using a tool.



4. Pull the filter case and remove it.



Separate the chloride filter → pre-filter → HEPA filter.



After replacing the filter, put the three types of filters together in the filter case. Then assemble in the reverse order of disassembly.
